Mission Statement

 Shift since 1994 overview of G&T mission statement - identified versus recommended students

- Difficult to iron out because of differing district policies for G&T program
- Provide programming, professional development, educational support.
 - Not a governing body
- Develop programs that would encourage diverse thinkers, not just academic thinkers
- Nourish and encourage learning for all stakeholders in school community
- Include NAGC standards
